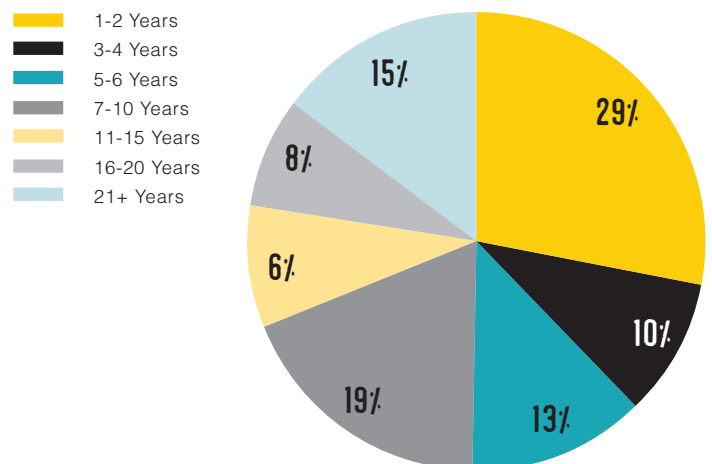

LENGTH OF RESIDENCE AT PRE-PURCHASE ADDRESS

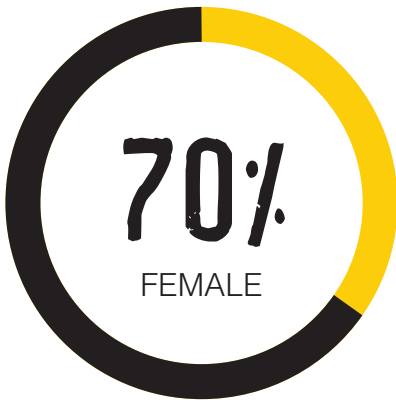

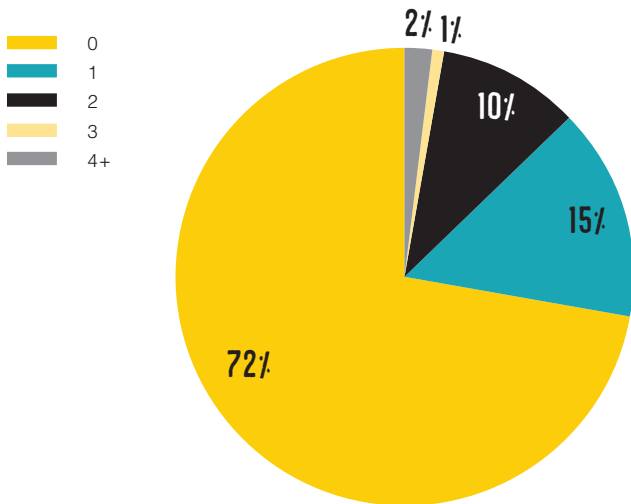
MARITAL STATUS



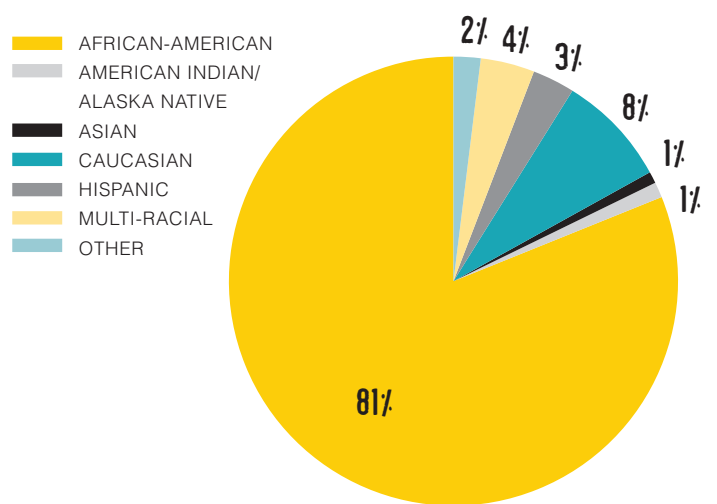

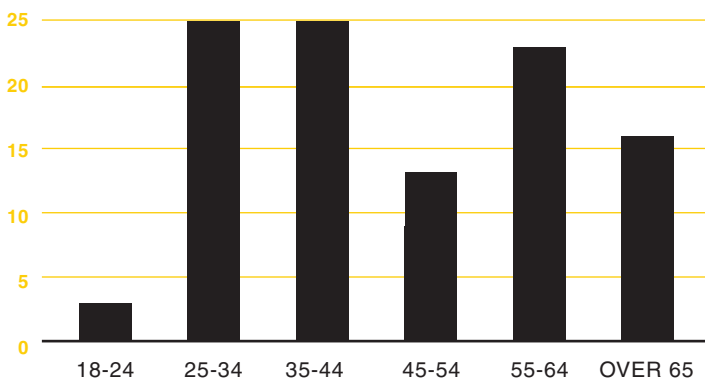
NUMBER OF CHILDREN IN HOUSEHOLD



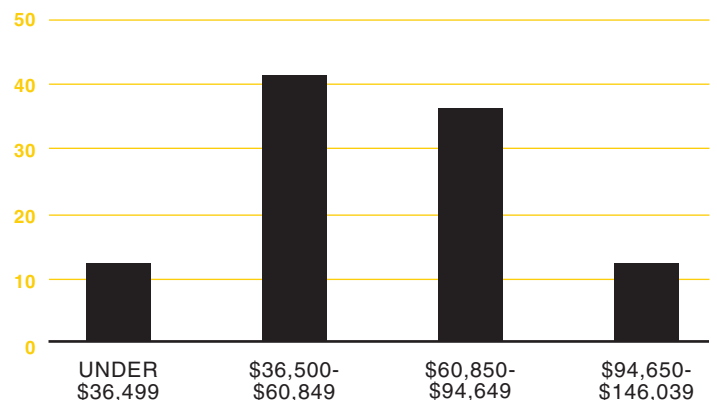
